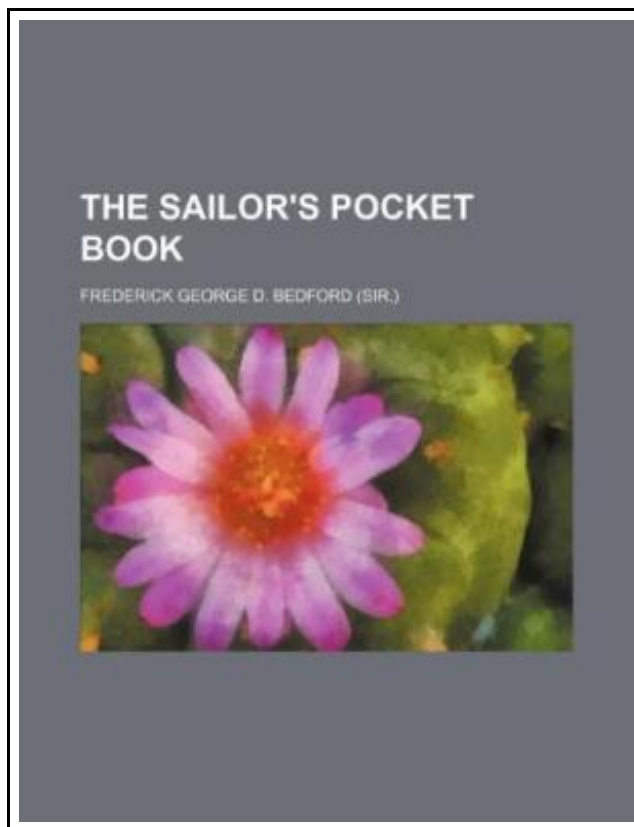

All boats should be supplied with a rain awning; two spare oars in addition to her complement; boat-hooks fitted with a stout lanyard, ending in an eye, secured to the hook, and seized two-thirds down the staff, to this eye a line should be attached (a boat-hook thus fitted will be found useful when boarding a vessel under weigh); a small grappling iron with a fathom and a-half of light chain; a stout line to throw on board vessels under weigh when desirous of boarding; scuttle-butts made to fit under the thwarts as large as the dimensions of the boat will conveniently allow; barecas, sails, boilers, c., complete. The oars should always be short as it must be remembered that the boats when provisioned will sit deep in the water. A pump should also be fitted under tlie coxswain s seat to discharge water at the stern. Rig.--The Slave Dhows on the East Coast of Africa are specially rigged for running with the Monsoons and they carry very large sails in proportion to their tonnage. The object, therefore, should be to rig boats so as to stand some chance of sailing on equal terms with them. The ordinary service rig will hardly allow of this, and after much experience it has been generally found that boats rigged with two sliding gunters are the best suited for cruising...
