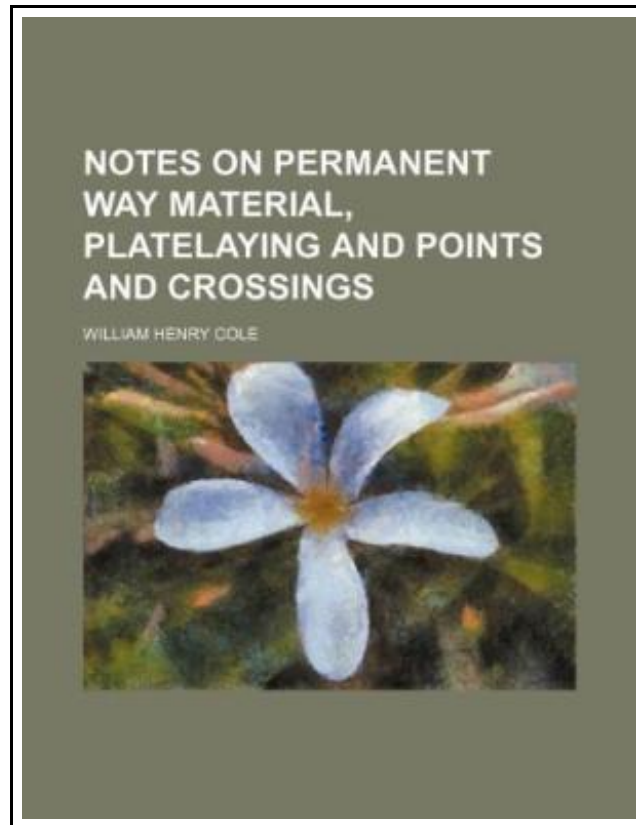

All the sleepers were notched and bored to a template beforehand; a carpenter and coolie could do 50 per diem. Two, and sometimes three, inspectors (including Mr. Champion) were simultaneously renewing the line on different sections of the division. Their methods differed considerably; but each was allowed to pursue his own, subject to no other interference than an occasional suggestion, and the results were in each case most satisfactory. On the metre gauge, Mr. H. G. Arnott, assistant engineer (who worked with the writer for several years), carried out very rapid renewals, with a large number of men distributed as follows: --Workmen, how employed. Cutting out fang-bolts and loosening fish-bolts. Carpenters with the above Blacksmiths Hammermen Laying rails in position Trolleying sleepers and small material Opening out and fishing rails and adzing sleepers Carpenters with the above Digging out ballast for joint sleepers Spacing and spiking sleeper J Packing--1st gang 2nd gang Trolleying old material to gate lodges Straightening and jim-crowing Picking up renewed small material Repairs of tools, handles, c.--carpenters blacksmiths. hammermen Signalmen In addition to the above, there were a tindal and 10 men with five carts for shifting...
