




The Little Red Lighthouse and the Great Gray Bridge

First published in 1942, this beloved children's classic has been restored to its original design and - for the first time - includes the recently discovered original watercolorpaintings by Lynd Ward. Built in 1880 of cast iron and steel, the 'fat and red and jolly' little lighthouse sits on the bank of the Hudson River in New York City. When the monumental George Washington Bridge is built overhead, the little lighthouse feels very, very small, but soon comes to understand its importance in guiding boats through dark and stormy weather.
